
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Bulldog 360 is supplemental learning, vibrant classes, and fun community building — all happening after school hours. Courses will be taught in person, on campus.



is required in this class.


Science Expedition; Primary; Tuesday; Ms. Alyssa




Musical Theatre Workshop; 1st - 8th grade; Wednesday; Ms. Liz






